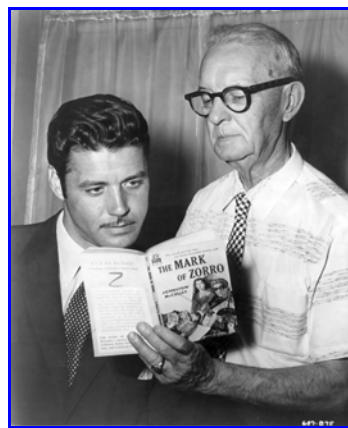


Selections from a Zorro Scrapbook





These images show some of the key influences on the creators of *La Zambra del Zorro* - the performing arts team of "Uehara & Sullivan".

On the previous page: Two posters for the 1920 silent film, *The Mark of Zorro* starring Douglas Fairbanks & Marguerite De La Motte. Poster for the 1940 version of *The Mark of Zorro*, followed by three black & white photos of the film showing Tyrone Power, including one dancing "*El Sombrero Blanco*" with Linda Darnell. Guy Williams (Bronx-born Armand Catalano) as the star of *Walt Disney's Zorro*, which took television audiences by storm in 1957 (including the young future librettist of *La Zambra del Zorro*). Guy with the creator of Zorro, Johnston McCulley. Guy with Fernando Lúpiz, Olympic gold medal fencing champion, who became Guy's protégé in the role of *El Zorro* on stage and screen in Argentina. Mentors & protégés: Tyrone Power as Diego with Paul Pallette as Fray Felipé in the 1940 film; Guy & Fernando in real life (ca. the late 1970s - 1980s). The dashing Guy as Diego and *El Zorro*.
